\*\*\*Now, information for all band members. There is an additional RCS fee in order to participate in band. The fee for the year is \$275 and this is payable through the on-line registration portion of the RCS website. To use this site, you will need to either log in (if you have already set up an account), or create an account. You will also need to know your student number (available on the Infinite Campus portal) and student's date of birth. Look for the Grades 5-8 Band button and register from there.

Band is a full-year class and will have lessons on the following days for woodwinds and brass:

St. Francis 7-8: Tuesday
St. Francis 6: Thursday

St. John 6-7-8: Monday, Wednesday and Thursday

I will be at St. Pius and Holy Spirit on Fridays for 5th grade band.

Mr. Krueger, our percussion instructor, will be teaching percussion lessons and will share his lesson schedule with the percussion students.

Because of Covid health concerns, we will not be having our full band rehearsals each week. Students will receive small group (no more than 3in a group) lessons as we begin the school year.
