

PSAT/NMSQT Test

Dear LHS Junior Parents,

On Wednesday, October 10th, your son or daughter will take the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT). The PSAT/NMSQT® assesses students' skills in three core areas: *reading*, *writing* and *language*, and *math*. The test is comprised of 139 questions and will take 2 hours and 45 minutes to complete. Students have been provided with the official student guide to the PSAT, as well as a full-length practice test. Khan Academy, a free online study resource, can also be utilized. On test day, students should arrive by 7:45 a.m. and bring number 2 pencils and an approved calculator (see student guide for list). Students will be able to access their scores online in early December, and will also receive a paper copy. Please visit
