



## RCS Chromebook Device Insurance for 2019-2020

For the 2019-2020 school year, the Rochester Catholic Schools Department of Technology will be providing in-house Chromebook device insurance for the school owned Chromebook devices that are lent to the Grade 6-11 students.

Providing in-house insurance will provide easier access and faster turnaround time for any necessary device repairs or replacements than using a third party device insurer/repair company.

The Chromebook insurance, which costs \$25 annually is automatically included in the RCS Chromebook usage fee.

There will be a deductible charged for each repair or replacement as follows:

- 1st damage/loss occurrence: up to \$25
- 2nd damage/loss occurrence: up to \$100
- 3rd damage/loss occurrence: up to \$200
- All subsequent damage/loss occurrences: up to \$300 (the estimated cost of a replacement device with license)

The deductible will not exceed the actual cost (parts and labor) of the particular repair or replacement.

To invoke a claim, the student must simply report the damage, and turn in the Chromebook to the Department of Technology staff or representative at their school. Your student may be supplied with a spare device while the original device is out for repair. In the event of a lost/stolen device, a police report will be required.

If the loss or damage results in a complete replacement of the device, the replacement device will be in good working order, but may not necessarily be a new device.

The Rochester Catholic Schools Department of Technology reserves the right to waive fees under certain circumstances.
